ACCEPTABLE SCREEN FOR HIDING YOUR TRASH AND RECYCLING CANS

Most trash cans are blue in color and are 96 gallon containers. The recycling cans are green and are 64 gallon containers.

The blue cans(96 gal) are 44" tall, 25" wide and 35" deep including the handles

The green cans(64 gal) are 41" tall, 24" wide and 28" deep including the handles

Here are the options you have:

- 1. Keep them in your garage
- 2. Keep them in your back/side yard behind your fence
- If you choose #3 you must hide your can so they cannot be seen from the front and side of your house, while driving by. This is a City of Anna ordinance. An acceptable fence that will hide your cans will need to be 48" wide, 66" long and 72" tall. This will hide one trash can of each type. This "L" will shaped configuration will adequately hide two cans. We recommend that you place concrete pavers down to roll your cans onto. This will keep them from sitting in any mud and will allow you to roll them in and out freely with little effort.

3. Keep them along side your house but behind an "L" shaped fence

Most people have done an excellent job in making this "L" shaped fence and even some have added a Texas Star to the front of this fence.
